Affected NWC service areas include:

Ulster Spring Pump Station

Ulster Spring, Albert Town, Bamboo, Freeman's Hall, Lot and German Town.

Wilson Run Pump Station

Wilson Run and Crown Lands.

Full operations will resume as soon as the turbidity subsides.
