## **JPS SINGLE PHASE ISSUE AFFECTING OPERATIONS AT LOGWOOD TREATMENT PLANT, HANOVER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that operations at its *Logwood Treatment plant* in **Hanover**, are currently affected by JPS single phase issue.

As a result, customers in sections of **Hanover** and **Westmoreland**, who are served by this facility will experience a disruption in their water supply.

The matter has been reported to the service provider and operations will resume as soon as the matter is resolved.

Areas affected include **Logwood, March Town, Cave Valley, Santoy, Orange Bay, Esher, Negril, Sheffield, Green Island, Salt Spring, Lucea, Elgin Town, Malcolm Heights, Haughton Court, Cauldwell, Pell River, First Hill, Archwell, Saxam, Bloody Bay, New Hope, Retreat, Nonpareil** and **Westland Mountain**.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
