DECLINE IN PRODUCTION AT BULSTRODE TREATMENT PLANT

...sections of Westmoreland affected

The National Water Commission is advising that there is a 50 per cent decline in production at the **Bulstrode Treatment Plant in Westmoreland**. This is due to levels of high turbidity at the facility.

During this period, customers served by this facility and especially those in elevated areas, will experience either low water pressure or periods without water. Normal operation will be restored as soon as the turbidity subsides.

Areas likely to be affected include **Burnt Savannah, Grange Hill, Toll-Gate, Fullersfield, Paul Island, Alma, Little London, Glasgow, Herring Piece, Broughton, Old Hope, New Hope and Bay Road**.
