The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that operations at the **Two Meeting Treatment Plant** in **Manchester**, have been suspended due to high levels of turbidity at the facility.

The NWC assures customers that normal operations will resume as soon as the turbidity subsides.

Areas affected include **Bailliston, Laughton Town, Junction, Mt. Mariah, Alston, Tweedside, Peckham, Cow Pen, Booth Town, Malcolm Town, Nine Mile, Zinc Shop, Santa Hill, Bullocks, Spaulding, Saungenetti, Limit, Sedburgh, Cobba, Villiage Street, Walderston, Mizpah, Mount Olivet, White Shop** and surrounding areas.
