Customers are being assured that their water supply will return as soon as the turbidity subsides.

Areas affected include **Christiana, Spalding, Coleyville, Chudleigh, Malton, Molliston, Devon, Farm, Richmond, Sedburgh, Whiteshop, Walderson, Cobbla, Silent Hill, Dump, Huddersfield, Succeed, Bryce, Dump, Dobson, Line of Parish, Silent Hill, Ticky Ticky, Laughton, Junction, Mt Mariah, Alston, Tweedside, Pecham, Bailliston, Cow Pen, Booth Town, Malcolm Town, Nine Mile, Limit** and surrounding areas.
