NWC WORKING TO RESTORE WATER SUPPLY TO ELEVATED AREAS IN ST JAMES

The National Water Commission (NWC) is reporting that while the emergency work at the Martha Brae Treatment Plant in Trelawny was completed, some customers in the elevated areas of St James are still experiencing a disruption in their water supply, as some time is required for the pipelines to be fully charged.

The NWC is working to restore water to some of these areas on or before Wednesday April 19, 2023, while those on the farther end of the network will see a return in their supply on Thursday April 20, 2023.

Affected areas include Ryhne Park, Coral Gardens, Cornwall Mountain, Palmyra, Mt Zion, Barrett Town, Providence Heights, Ironshore, Torado Heights, Norwood, Rose Heights, Albion Heights, Melbourne, Rose Mount, Flower Hill and Paradise.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience caused and craves the continued patience and understanding of its valued customers.
