**HIGH TURBIDITY DISRUPTS WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS
OF ST. JAMES, WESTMORELAND AND TRELAWNY**

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Cambridge Treatment Plant** in **St. James** and the **Troy pumping station** in **Trelawny**, for the disruption in their water supply due to high turbidity at the facilities.

The NWC is assuring customers that their water supply will return as soon as the turbidity subsides.

Areas affected in **St James** include **Bickersteth, Seven Rivers, Richmond Hill, Shortwood** and **Cambridge**

Areas affected in **Westmoreland** include **Ducketts, Greenwich, Bethel Town, Argyle Mountain, Lambs River, Jerusalem Mountain, Herring Piece** and **Mijam Mountain.**

Areas affected in **Trelawny** include **Troy** and **New Hope.**

The NWC regrets any inconvenience caused and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
