The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologize to customers served by **Cambridge Treatment Plant** in **St James** and the **Sherwood Pumping station** in **Trelawny** for the disruption in their water supply due to high turbidity.

Customers are being assured that their water supply will return as soon as the turbidity subsides.

Areas affected include in **St James** include **Bickersteth, Seven Rivers, Richmond Hill, Shortwood, Cambridge** and **Cambridge Proper**.

Areas affected in **Westmoreland** include **Ducketts, Greenwich, Grange, Bethel Town, Argyle Mountain** and **Lambs River**.

Areas affected in Trelawny include Sherwood, Peidmount, Reserve and Coxheath.
