**RESCHEDULED MAINTENANCE WORK TO DISRUPT WATER
SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF HANOVER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising customers served by the **Shettlewood Pumping Station in Hanover**, that it will be undertaking maintenance work at the facility on **Wednesday, August 4, 2021 between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.** As a result, customers will be without water supply during the period.

The works, initially scheduled for Thursday, July 29, 2021, had been postponed.

Areas to be affected include: **Chester Castle, Ramble, Knocklava, Copse, PEARCES Village, Shettlewood, Friendship, Lethe, Burnt Ground, Mount Peto and Haughton Grove.**

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
