**TESTING PHASE OF WESTMORELAND WATER SUPPLY
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT COMMENCES THIS TUESDAY**

The National Water Commission wishes to advise that it is commencing the testing phase of its Westmoreland Water Supply Improvement Project this Tuesday, August 17, 2021. In this phase, the agency will be conducting adjustments that will result in low or high water pressure on Tuesdays and Thursdays beginning at 6:00 p.m. to 12 noon on the following days (Wednesdays and Fridays respectively).

Areas to be affected include Old Hope, Bay Road, Albany Housing Scheme, Williamsfield, Fort Williams, Strawberry, Flower Hill, Grange Hill, Burnt Savannah, Toll Gate, Little London, Broughton, New Hope, Fullersfield and surrounding areas.

The testing phase will continue for six (6) weeks.
