**LEAK REPAIR WORK TO DISRUPT OPERATIONS
AT VICTORIA TOWN FACILITY, MANCHESTER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, operations at the Victoria Town facility in **Manchester**, will be temporarily suspended on **Tuesday August 31, 2021**, between the hours of **9:00 am** and **5:00 pm**.

This disruption in supply is to facilitate leak repair on a 6-inch pumping main in the community of Asia.

Every effort will be made to complete the necessary repair work and restore water within the time specified.

Areas to be affected include **Victoria Town, Queen Town, Pusey Hill, Campbell's Field, Cassava Piece, Pratville, Cross Keys, Restore, Smithfield, Grove Town, Warwick, Marlie Hill, Asia, Sweetland, Bussue Lane, Porter Town, Reserve** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
