MAINTENANCE WORK TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF MANCHESTER

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, it will be carrying out maintenance work at the Comfort Pump station in Manchester, on Thursday September 2, 2021, between the hours of 9:00 am and 2:00 pm.

As a result, customers served by the Comfort, Porus and Broadleaf facilities will be without water supply.

Areas to be affected include **Porus, Trinity, Red Berry, Comfort, Broadleaf, Royal Flat, Williamsfield, Land Settlement, Melrose Mews Housing scheme, Handbury, Kendal, New Green, Ingleside, sections of Grey Ground, Grove Place, Tree Chains, Patrick Road, Gordon Road, Cypclair Close, Bonitto Crescent, Crest Haven, Dorby** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
