MAINTENANCE WORK TO AFFECT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF ST. ELIZABETH AND MANCHESTER

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, it will be carrying out maintenance work at the **Spur Tree facility** on **Thursday, October 14, 2021**, between the hours of **9:00 am** and **8:00 pm**.

As a result of this work, customers in sections of **St Elizabeth** and **Manchester**, who are served by the **Greater Mandeville Water Supply System**, will experience either low water pressure or no water.

The NWC is assuring customers that every effort will be made to complete the necessary work and restore water within the time specified. The company is also urging customers to store water for use during the outlined period.

Areas to be affected include: *Pepper Downs, sections of New Forest, Farm, sections of Nain, Sea Air, Spur Tree, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balvenie, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Richmond, Old England, Gray Ground, Heartease, Woodlawn Housing Scheme, Caledonia Road, Caledonia Meadows, May Day, Brumalia Road, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Balcarres, McKinley Road, Gordon Road* and surrounding areas.
