**EMERGENCY MAINTENANCE WORK TO DISRUPT
WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF ST ELIZABETH**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, operation at the **Hopewell Pump Station in St Elizabeth**, will be temporarily suspended on **Thursday October 14, 2021**, between the hours of **9:00 am** and **4:00 pm**.

This disruption in supply is to facilitate emergency maintenance work at the facility. As a result, customers served by this facility will be without piped water supply.

Areas to be affected include **Parottee, Hill Top, Fort Charles, Stonefield, Pondsides, Spice Grove, Tatchwalk, Arlington, Vineyard, Fullerswood, Cataboo, Frenchman, Punches** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
