IN SECTIONS OF ST. ELIZABETH AND MANCHESTER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, it will be carrying out urgent maintenance work at the Spur Tree and Gutter facilities, on Friday November 5, 2021 between the hours of 9:00 am and 6:00 pm.

As a result of this work, operations at the **Greater Mandeville Water Supply facility** will be temporarily suspended.

The NWC is assuring customers that every effort will be made to restore water within the time specified. The company is also urging customers to store water for use during the outlined period.

Areas to be affected include: *Pepper, Downs, sections of New Forest, Farm, sections of Nain, Sea Air, Spur Tree, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balvenie, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Richmond, Old England, Grey Ground, Heartease, Woodlawn Housing Scheme, Caledonia Road, Caledonia Meadows, May Day, Brumalia Road, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Balcarres, McKinley Road, Gordon Road, Porus, New Port, Hillside, Albion, Knock Patrick, Lincoln, Huntley* and surrounding areas.
