**EMERGENCY PIPELINE REPAIR WORK TO DISRUPT  
WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF MANCHESTER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising customers served by the **Porus Pumping station** in **Manchester**, that they will experience a disruption in their water supply on Saturday November 6, 2021, between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm.

This disruption is to facilitate emergency repair on a 10-inch pumping main on East Ingleside road.

Areas to be affected include **Porus, Trinity, Red Berry, Comfort, Broadleaf, Royal Flat, Williamsfield, Land Settlement, Hanbury, Kendal, New Green, Ingleside, section of Grey Ground, Grove Mount, Three Chains, Patrick Road, Gordon Road, Cypclair Close, Bonitto Crescent, Crest Haven, Melrose Mews, Dorby Subdivision, Land Settlement** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
