**URGENT PIPELINE REPAIR WORK TO DISRUPT
OPERATIONS AT PORUS FACILITY, MANCHESTER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, operations at the **Porus** facility in **Manchester**, will be temporarily suspended from **10:00 pm Wednesday November 17** through to **6:00 pm Thursday November 18, 2021**, to facilitate repairs to a 10-inch pumping main on the Comfort main road.

During this period, customers served by the Porus, Comfort and Broadleaf facilities will experience a disruption in their water supply.

Areas likely to be affected **Porus, Trinity, Red Berry, Comfort, Broadleaf, Royal Flat, Williamsfield, Land Settlement, Hanbury, Kendal, New Green, Ingleside, section of Grey Ground, Grove Mount, Three Chains, Patrick Road, Gordon Road, Cypclair Close, Bonitto Crescent, Crest Haven, Melrose Mews, Dorby Subdivision, Land Settlement** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
