The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, due to scheduled JPSCO maintenance work to be carried out on **Thursday, February 24** and **Friday February 25, 2022**, customers served by the **Baileston, Two Meeting** and **Comfort** facilities in **Manchester**, will experience a disruption in their water supply.

Areas likely to be affected include: **Laughton Town, Junction, Mt Mariah, Alston, Tweedside, Peckham, Waterworks, Baileston, Knox, Sedgeburgh, Cow Pen, Booth Town, Malcolm Town, Nine Mile, Santa Hill, Bullocks, Spalding, Saungenetti, Limit, Cobbla, Village Street, Walderston, Mizpah, Mt Olivett, White Shop, Bonitto Crescent, Crest Haven, Dorby, Ingleside**, sections of **Grey Ground, Grove Place** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
