**PIPELINE REPAIR WORK TO AFFECT
WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF MANCHESTER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising customers served by the **Comfort pumping station in Manchester**, that they will experience a disruption in their water supply from **9:00 pm Wednesday May 25** through to **6:00 pm Thursday May 26, 2022**.

This disruption in service is to facilitate urgent leak repair to a 10” pumping main on the Comfort main road.

Customers are being assured that every effort will be made to complete the necessary repair and restore supply within the specified time.

Areas to be affected include **Porus, Trinity, Red Berry, Comfort, Broadleaf, Royal Flat, Williamsfield, Land Settlement, Hanbury, Kendal, New Green, Ingleside, section of Grey Ground, Grove Mount, Three Chains, Patrick Road, Gordon Road, Cypclair Close, Bonitto Crescent, Crest Haven, Melrose Mews, Dorby Subdivision, Land Settlement** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the period of downtime.
