**MAINTENANCE WORK TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY
IN SECTIONS OF ST. ELIZABETH AND MANCHESTER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that it will be carrying out maintenance work at the **Gutters** facility in **Manchester** on **Wednesday, June 8, 2022**, between the hours of **9:0am** and **7:00pm**.

As a result, customers in sections of **St. Elizabeth** and **Manchester** served by the **Greater Mandeville Water Supply System** will experience a disruption in their water supply.

Areas to be affected include: **Pepper, Downs, Prospect, sections of New Forrest, Farm, Nain, Sea Air, Spur Tree, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balevine, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Richmond, Old England, Gray Ground, New Port, Ward Avenue, Hartease, Albion, May Day, Brumalia, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Lincoln, Huntley** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
