**EMERGENCY PIPELINE REPAIR WORK TO DISRUPT
WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF MANCHESTER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that operations at the **Moravia Treatment** plant in **Manchester**, will be suspended from **10:00 pm Wednesday June 29 through to 6:00 pm Thursday June 30, 2022**. This disruption in supply is to facilitate emergency pipeline repair work.

Areas to be affected **include Christiana, Spalding, Coleyville, Chudleigh, Malton, Molliston, Devon, Farm, Richmond, Sedburgh, Whiteshop, Walderson, Cobbla, Silent Hill, Dump, Huddersfield, Succeed, Bryce, Dump, Dobson, Line of Parish, Silent Hill, Tick Ticky** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
