MAINTENANCE WORK TO AFFECT WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF WESTMORELAND AND TRELAWNY

The National Water Commission is advising customers served by the **Bulstrode Treatment Plant** in **Westmoreland**, that they will experience a disruption in their water supply on **Monday August 8, 2022**, between the hours of **9:00 am** and **6:00 pm**.

Areas to be affected include **Burnt Savannah, Grange Hill, Toll-Gate, Fullersfield, Paul Island, Alma, Little London, Glasgow, Herring Piece, Broughton, Old Hope, New Hope** and **Bay Road**.

At the sametime, customers served by the **Barnstaple** facility in **Trelawny**, will experience a disruption in their water supply from **Monday August 8** to **Tuesday August 9, 2022**.

Areas to be affected include **Barnstaple, Westwood, Stewart Town, Jackson Town, Jackson Hill** and **Mahogany Hall**.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience these disruptions may cause and urges customers to store water for use.
