## **MAINTENANCE WORK TO AFFECT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF HANOVER AND WESTMORELAND**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, it will be carrying out maintenance work at the *Logwood* Treatment plant in **Hanover**, on **Tuesday August 9, 2022**, between the hours **9:00 am** and **6:00 pm**.

As a result, customers in sections of **Hanover** and **Westmoreland**, who are served by this facility, will experience a disruption in their water supply.

Areas to be affected include **Logwood, March Town, Cave Valley, Santoy, Orange Bay, Esher, Negril, Sheffield, Green Island, Salt Spring, Lucea, Elgin Town, Malcolm Heights, Haughton Court, Cauldwell, Pell River, First Hill, Archwell, Saxam, Bloody Bay, Negril West End, Norman Manley Boulevard, New Hope, Retreat, Nonpareil and Westland Mountain.**

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the period.
