Emergency Maintenance work to affect Greater Mandeville Supply

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to advise that the Greater Mandeville Water Supply System will be operating at reduced capacity due to an emergency maintenance work at the Gutters and Spur Tree facilities on Wednesday, August 17, 2022 between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

As a result, customers will experience low water pressure, intermittent supply or no water conditions

- Pepper, Downs, Spur Tree, Prospect, sections of New Forest, Nain, Sea Air, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balvenie, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Hillside, Richmond, Old England, Grey Ground, New Port, Wards Avenue, Heartease, Knockpartick, Woodlawn Housing scheme, Caledonia Road, Caledonia Meadows, Albion, May Day, Brumalia, Marshalls Pen, Waltham, Perth, Cedar Gardens, Mike Town, Lincoln, Huntley and surrounding areas.
