**EMERGENCY LEAK REPAIR WORK TO AFFECT

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, the **Porus Pumping Station** in **Manchester**, will be shut down from **10:00 pm Friday, November 11, 2022** to **6:00 pm Saturday November 12, 2022**.

This disruption in supply is to facilitate emergency leak repair work on the Royal Flat main road. Every effort will be made to complete the work within the time specified and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.

Areas to be affected **Porus, Trinity, Red Berry, Comfort, Broadleaf, Royal Flat, Williamsfield, Land Settlement, Hanbury, Kendal, New Green, Ingleside, section of Grey Ground, Grove Place, Tree Chains, Patrick Road, Gordon Road, Cypclair Close, Bonetto Crescent, Crest Haven, Melrose Mews, Dorby.**
