OPERATIONS TO BE SUSPENDED AT GUTTERS FACILITY, MANCHESTER

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, operations at the Gutters facility in Manchester, will be temporarily suspended on Wednesday November 23, 2022, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to facilitate maintenance work.

Areas to be affected include *Spur Tree, Prospect, sections of New Forest, Nain, Sea Air, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balevine, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Richmond, Old England, Grey Ground, New Port, Wards Avenue, Hartease, Woodlawn Housing scheme, Caledonia Road, Caledonia Meadows, Albion, May Day, Brumalia, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Lincoln, Huntley* and surrounding areas.

Customers are being assured that the NWC will be working assiduously to restore water within the time specified.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
