TRAFFIC DIVERSION FOR FAIRFIELD IRWIN PIPELINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

As part of the ongoing **Fairfield Irwin Pipeline Replacement Project** in **St. James**, the National Water Commission (NWC) is advising the public of a temporary traffic diversion and road closure to facilitate critical work. The project, which is currently at approximately fifty percent (50%) completion, is aimed at improving the water supply for approximately 9,000 customers in the communities of Fairfield Irwin, Cashew Grove, and Tucker Avenue.

To safely continue the installation of 2 kilometres of 200mm (8-inch) ductile iron pipeline between Fairfield Avenue and the Fairfield Tank, it has become necessary to temporarily close a section of the roadway from the entrance of **Fairfield Crescent** onto the dual carriageway along the **Fairfield Irwin** main road.
