**URGENT PIPELINE WORKS TO IMPACT OPERATIONS
AT GUTTERS FACILITY IN ST ELIZABETH**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, operations at the **Gutters Pumping Station** in **St. Elizabeth**, will be temporarily suspended on **Wednesday, October 30, 2024**, between the hours of **9:00 a.m.** and **7:00 pm**. This disruption in service is to facilitate urgent pipeline connection works. During this period, operation at the **Greater Mandeville Water Supply System** will also be affected.

Areas to be affected include **Pepper, Downs, Gutters, Spur Tree, Prospect**, sections of **New Forest, Nain, Sea Air, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balvenie, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Hillside, Richmond, Old England, Grey Ground, Newport, Ward Avenue, Heartease, Knockpartick, Woodlawn Housing Scheme, Caledonia Road, Caledonia Meadows, Albion, May Day, Brumalia, Marshalls Pen, Waltham, Perth, Cedar Gardens, Mike Town, Lincoln, Huntley** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
