ELECTRICAL CHALLENGE AFFECTS WATER SUPPLY

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to advise that some customers in the parishes of **St. Catherine** and **Clarendon** are currently experiencing a disruption in regular water supply as a result of single phase electricity fault at the Eastern Headworks 'H' and Chatteau Deepwell facilities.

The Company is also advising that a technical team of the Jamaica Public Service Company (JPSCo) has been notified and are making every effort to have this issue resolved quickly.

Areas Affected include: **Kent Village, Spanish Town Road, Molynes Road, Washington Boulevard, Sections of Downtown Kingston, Hamilton Gardens, Christian Gardens & Pen, Newland Road, Cumberland, Cedar Grove, Edgewater, Waterford, Gregory Park, Braeton, Independence City, Hellshire, E, Chatteau, Heart Well Gardens, and Maryvale Meadows.**
