The National Water Commission is advising some customers in St Catherine and the Corporate areas, who are served by the Bybrook #1 and #4 Treatment Plants that the disruption currently being experienced is as a result of a JPSCo power supply problem.

Affected areas are: **Kent Village, Spanish Town Road, Molynes Road, Washington Boulevard, sections of Downtown Kingston, Hamilton Gardens, Christian Gardens & Pen, Newland Road, Cumberland, Cedar Grove, Edgewater, Waterford, Gregory Park, Braeton, Independence City, Hellshire, Tulloch Springs, sections of Kingston and Portmore**

Customers are being assured that the National Water Commission will restore their regular water supply as soon as normality returns to the facilities.
