WATER DISRUPTIONS IN ST. ELIZABETH AND MANCHESTER.

The National Water Commission (NWC) is apologizing to customers, who are served by the **Newton** system in St. Elizabeth, for the disruption they are experiencing in their water supply. This is due to a JPSCO single phase that is affecting operations at the facility.

The affected areas are **Newton, Barton, Haughton and surrounding areas.**

Meanwhile in Manchester, the **Two Meeting Treatment Plant** is out of operation due to turbidity. As result, customers in **Spalding, George North, Denham Farm, Glenco** and surrounding areas are without regular water supply.

The NWC apologizes for any inconvenience caused by these disruptions and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
