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NWC Continues NRW Preparation Exercises Across the Corporate Area

The **National Water Commission (NWC)** in collaboration with its Non-Revenue Water (NRW) Co-management partners **MIYA**, will continue the implementation of a hydraulic modeling exercise throughout the Corporate Area.

The hydraulic exercise involves the collection of pressure and flow data through tapping points made on major transmission pipelines within the distribution network.

The data gathered would better enable the Commission in understanding the behaviour patterns of its piping network, which would result in a reduction in pipeline ruptures, low pressures and supply interruptions. This would mean having balanced network pressures and improved supplies to customers.

The hydraulic exercise is now about 93% complete and will involve carrying out minor road excavations which would result in some traffic interruptions.

The exercise will be proceeding to the following locations in the Corporate Area within the coming week:

- Shortwood Road
- Oliver Road
- East Kings House Road
- Dumbarton Avenue
- Washington Boulevard from Mandela Highway
- Elgin Road
- Deanery Road and Upper Elletson Road

The NWC is assuring the public that all excavated roadways will be reinstated and asks for the public's cooperation as it carries out this necessary improvement works.

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
