POWER SUPPLY CHALLENGES AFFECT OPERATIONS IN SECTIONS OF ST. ELIZABETH AND MANCHESTER

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Bogue Well in St. Elizabeth**, and the **Baileston Relift in Manchester**, for the disruption they are currently experiencing in their water supply, which is due to power supply challenges affecting the facilities.

The matter has been reported to the power service provider and operations will resume as soon as normality returns to the stations.

Areas affected include:

In St. Elizabeth

Bogue, Cabbage Valley, Elim, Two Mile Wood, Braes River, Georges Valley, E3 Road, Grosmond, Wilton, Air House and Rice Peace.

In Manchester

Baileston, Top Alston, Spaulding, Knox, Sedgeburgh, Limit and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience caused and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
