The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Nampriell** and **Jerusalem Mountain** systems in **Westmorland**, for the disruption in their water supply, due to electrical challenges at the facilities.

Every effort is being made to resolve the challenges and restore water to the affected areas by **Thursday, April 18, 2019**.

Areas affected include: **Orange Hill, Mt. Airy, Good Hope, Duck Pond, White Hall, Jerusalem Mountain, Herring Piece, Mijam Mountain** and surrounding areas.

At the same time, customers in **Woodland, Hanover** are without water supply as a result of mechanical challenges at the **Woodland** facility.

The maintenance team is working assiduously to restore water supply by **Thursday, April 18, 2019**.
