**OPERATIONAL CHALLENGES AFFECT WATER SUPPLY
IN SECTIONS OF ST. JAMES, TRELAWNY AND WESTMORELAND**

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Stonehenge Pumping Station** in **St. James**, **Bounty Hall Booster** in **Trelawny** and the **Barneyside Relift** in **Westmoreland**, for the disruption in their water supply due to electro-mechanical challenges at the facilities.

Affected areas include: **Stonehenge**, **Catskin**, **Belfont**, **Bounty Hall**, **Hermitage**, **Barneyside**, **Cornwall Mountain**, **Cold Spring**, **Myers Hall**, **Mount Stewart** and **Belvedere**.

Every effort is being made to resolve the challenges at the **Bounty Hall** and **Barneyside** facilities by **Tuesday, April 30, 2019** and at the **Stonehenge facility** by **Monday, May 6, 2019**.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience these disruptions may have caused and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
