## **DAMAGED PIPELINES DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF HANOVER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, land slippage has resulted in the dislocation of sections of its pipeline network in **Mt. Pleasant, Hanover**. As a result, customers served by the **Clifton Relift**, are experiencing a disruption in their water supply.

The NWC is assuring customers that every effort is being made to complete the necessary repairs and restore water to the affected areas by **7:00 pm Thursday, April 25, 2019**.

Areas affected include: **Water Cress, Middlesex, Mt. Pleasant, Richmond, Blenheim, Dias, Williamsfield, Mount Piece, Clifton, Cacoon, Greenland** and surrounding areas.
