IN SECTIONS OF ST. JAMES AND WESTMORELAND**

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Cambridge Treatment Plant** in **St. James**, and the **Jerusalem Mountain** Spring in **Westmoreland**, for the disruption in their water supply due to high turbidity at the facilities.

The NWC is assuring customers that their water supply will return as soon as the turbidity subsides.

Areas affected include: **Bickersteth, Seven Rivers, Richmond Hill, Shortwood, Cambridge, Ducketts, Grange, Bethel Town, Argyle Mountain, Lambs River, Jerusalem Mountain, Herring Piece** and **Mijam Mountain**.
