POWER SUPPLY CHALLENGES DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF ST. ELIZABETH AND MANCHESTER

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Union Well** in **St. Elizabeth** and the **Victoria Town** facility in **Manchester**, for the disruption in the water supply, due to power supply challenges.

The matter has been reported to the power service provider and water will be restored to the affected areas as soon as the matter is resolved.

Areas affected in **St. Elizabeth** include: *Union, Raheem, Marlborough, Russell Hill, Phoenix Park, Balaclava, St. Paul's Roses Valley, Content, Free Town, Comfort Hall, Ever Green, Mount Pleasant and Lineside.*

Areas affected in **Manchester** include: *Victoria Town, Queen Town, Pusey Hill, Campbell's Field, Cassava Piece, Pratville, Cross Keys, Restore, Smithfield, Grove Town, Warwick, Marlie Hill and Asia.*
