**OPERATIONAL CHALLENGES DISRUPT WATER
SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF HANOVER AND TRELAWNY**

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Sandy Bay Relift** and **Seaview Relift** in **Hanover**, for the disruption in their water supply due to mechanical challenges at both facilities.

The NWC is assuring customers that it is working assiduously to resolve the challenges at the facilities and restore water supply to the affected areas by **Monday, May 13, 2019**.

Affected areas include: **Montpelier, Lookout, Seaview, Bamboo and Orchard Gardens**.

At the same time, customers served by the **Bounty Hall** facility in **Trelawny**, are without water as a result of electrical challenges.

Every effort is being made to resolve the challenges and restore water by **Wednesday, May 8, 2019**.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience caused and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.

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
