## **JPSCO POWER OUTAGE DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF ST. ELIZABETH AND MANCHESTER**

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers in sections of **St. Elizabeth** and **Manchester**, who are served by the **Gutters** facility in **Manchester**, for the disruption in their water supply due to JPSCo power outage.

Areas affected include: *Spur Tree, Prospect, sections of New Forest, Nain, Sea Air, Greenvale, Hatfield, Dunrobin, Balevine, Mandeville Town, Georges Valley, Richmond, Old England, Grey Ground, New Port, Wards Avenue, Hartease, Woodlawn Housing scheme, Caledonia Road, Caledonia Meadows, Albion, May Day, Brumalia, Marshalls Pen, Mike Town, Lincoln, Huntley* and surrounding areas.

The matter has been reported to the power service provider and operations will resume as soon as normality returns to the facility.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this may cause and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
