WATER DISRUPTION IN SECTIONS OF ST. JAMES AND HANOVER

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to advise that, it is working assiduously to restore water to customers served by the **Stonehenge Pumping Station** in **St. James**, by **Friday, May 17, 2019**.

The Agency had reported that supply would have been restored on **Monday, May 6, 2019**, however, further challenges made this deadline unattainable.

Affected areas include: **Stonehenge, Catskin, Belfont, Bounty Hall, Hermitage, Barneyside, Cornwall Mountain, Cold Spring, Myers Hall, Mount Stewart and Belvedere.**

At the same time, customers served by the **Copse Relift** in **Hanover**, are also without water due to mechanical challenges.

Every effort is being to resolve the challenges and restore water to the affected areas by **Friday, May 10, 2019**.

Affected areas include: **Copse, Friendship, Eden Lethe** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience these disruptions may have caused and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
