WATER DISRUPTION ... SECTIONS OF HANOVER AND MANCHESTER AFFECTED

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to advise that, due to single phase at the **Shettlewood** pumping station in **Hanover**, customers are experiencing a disruption in their water supply.

The problem has been reported to the power service provider, and full operation will resume as soon as normality returns to the station.

Areas affected include: **Shettlewood, Chester Castle, Ramble, Copse, Knockalva, Lethe, Burnt Ground, Mount Peto, Friendship, Pearces, Village, McField, Haddo, Haughton Grove** and surrounding areas.

At the same time, customers served by the **Bachelor's Hall** Relift in **Hanover** and the **Victoria Town** system in **Manchester**, are experiencing a disruption in their water supply due to electrical challenges at both facilities.

Areas affected in Hanover include: **First Hill, Bachelor's Hall, St. Simon** and surrounding areas.

Areas affected in **Manchester** include: **Victoria Town, Queen Town, Pusey Hill, Campbell's Field, Cassava Piece, Pratville, Cross Keys, Restore, Smithfield, Grove Town, Warwick, Marlie Hill, Asia** and surrounding areas.
