## WATER DISRUPTION

...sections of Hanover and St. Elizabeth affected

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to advise that, due to single phase at the **Shettlewood** pumping station in **Hanover**, customers are experiencing a disruption in their water supply.

The problem has been reported to the power service provider, and full operation will resume as soon as normality returns to the station.

Areas affected include: **Shettlewood, Chester Castle, Ramble, Copse, Knockalva, Lethe, Burnt Ground, Mount Peto, Friendship, Pearces, Village, McField, Haddo, Haughton Grove, Sandy Bay and Montpelier.**

At the same time, customers served by the **Union Well** in **St Elizabeth**, are experiencing a disruption in their water supply due to electrical challenges at the facility.

Areas affected include: **Union, Raheem, Marlborough, Russell Hill, Phoenix Park, Balaclava, St. Paul's, Roses Valley, Comfort Hall, Content, Free Town, Evergreen, Mount Pleasant, Beverley** and surrounding areas.

Every effort is being made to resolve the challenges and restore water to the affected areas by **Friday, May 10, 2019.**
