OPERATIONAL CHALLENGES AFFECT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF TRELAWNY AND WESTMORELAND

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Mt. Edgecombe** facility in **Westmoreland**, for the disruption in their water supply, due to power supply challenges at the facility.

The matter has been reported to the power supply provider and water will return as soon as the situation is resolved.

Areas affected include: **Whitehouse, Farm, Gordon, Culloden and Southsea Park.**

At the same time, customers served by the **Chester Relift** in **Trelawny**, are without water supply as a result of high turbidity at the facility.

Areas affected include: **Chester, Perth Town, Reserve, Graves End and Garreadu.**
