### **NWC WORKING TO RESTORE WATER SUPPLY**

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologise to customers served by the **Clarke's Town** facility in **Trelawny**, for the continued disruption in their water supply due to mechanical challenges.

The Agency had reported that operations would have resumed on Wednesday May 21, 2019, however further challenges made this deadline unattainable. Every effort is being made to resolve the challenges and restore water to the affected areas by **Monday, May 27, 2019**.

In the meantime, and until the situation is resolved, the company will continue to truck water to affected customers.

Areas affected include: **Clarke's Town, Duncans, Duncans Hill, Hyde, Kinloss, Crawle, Gibraltar, Georgia, Logwood Walk** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience caused and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
