HIGH TURBIDITY AFFECTS WATER SUPPLY TO SECTIONS OF ST. JAMES AND HANOVER

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologize to customers served by the **Dantrout** Pumping station in **St. James** and the **Cascade** Pumping station in **Hanover**, for the disruption in their water supply, due to high levels of turbidity at the facilities.

Affected areas include:

In St. James

Dantrout, Marchmont Road, German Town, Seaford Town, St. Leonards, Mt. Spring, Coffee Ground, Chesterfield and Gardener.

In Hanover

Cascade, Pondside, Great Valley, Jericho, Retrieve, Claremont, Smithfield, Willoughby and Cold Spring.

The NWC is assuring customers that normal operations will resume as soon as the turbidity subsides.
