WATER DISRUPTION

The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologize to customers served by the **Jerusalem Mountain** facility in **Westmoreland**, for the continued disruption in their water supply, due to mechanical challenges at the facility.

The Agency had reported that operations would have resumed on **Tuesday, May 28, 2019**, however further challenges made this deadline unattainable. Every effort is being made to resolve the challenges and restore water to the affected areas by **Monday, June 3, 2019**.

Areas affected include: **Jerusalem Mountain, Herring Piece, Mijam Mountain** and surrounding areas.

At the same time, customers served by the **New Milns** Pumping station in **Hanover** are experiencing a disruption in their water supply due to mechanical challenges

Areas affected include: **New Milns, Welcome, Cacoon, Nyerere Farm, Haddington, Watford Hill** and **Woodland**.

Every effort will be made to resolve the challenges and restore water to the affected areas by **Wednesday, June 5, 2019**.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience caused and craves the patience and understanding of its valued customers.
