The National Water Commission (NWC) wishes to apologize to customers served by the **Canaan** Deepwell in **St. James**, the **Bounty Hall** and **Duansvale** systems in **Trelawny** and the **Coffee Grove** system in **Manchester**, for the disruption in their water supply due to power supply challenges.

The NWC is assuring customers that their water supply will be restored as soon as the issues are resolved.

Areas affected include:

In St. James

Canaan, Chatham, Content, Adelphi, Dumfries, Somerton and Blyston.

In Trelawny

Bounty Hall, Hermitage and surrounding areas served by the **Bounty Hall** system, **Daunsvale, Duansvale Housing scheme, New Forrest, Chester, Perth Town, Reserve, Graves End** and **Garreadu** served by the **Duansvale** system.

In Manchester

Coffee Grove and surrounding areas.
