SCHEDULED JPSCO POWER OUTAGE TO DISRUPT WATER SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF ST. JAMES, HANOVER AND WESTMORELAND

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, due to scheduled JPSCO maintenance work between the hours of **8:00 am** and **5:00 pm** on **Saturday, June 1, 2019**, some customers in **St. James, Hanover** and **Westmoreland** will be without piped water.

The NWC urges customers to store water for use during the period they will be without and assures them that water will be restored following the return of the power supply.
