**EMERGENCY LEAK REPAIR WORK TO AFFECT WATER  
SUPPLY IN SECTIONS OF HANOVER AND WESTMORELAND**

The National Water Commission (NWC) is advising that, operations at the *Logwood* Treatment plant in **Hanover**, will be temporarily suspended between the hours of **1:00am** and **6:00pm** on **Wednesday, June 5, 2019**, to facilitate emergency leak repair work along the distribution line.

As a result, customers in **Hanover** and **Westmoreland**, who are served by this facility, will be without water supply.

Areas to be affected include: **Logwood, March Town, Cave Valley, Santoy, Orange Bay, Esher, Negril, Sheffield, Green Island, Salt Spring, Lucea, Elgin Town, Malcolm Heights, Haughton Court, Cauldwell, Pell River, First Hill, Archwell, Saxam, Bloody Bay, Negril West End, New Hope, Retreat, Nonpareil, Westland Mountain** and surrounding areas.

The NWC regrets any inconvenience this disruption may cause and urges customers to store water for use during the outlined period.
